Executive Summary

Central Academy for State Forest Service, Dehradun Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India is mandated with conducting short term training courses for personnel of other departments with an objective to foster enhanced co-operation and convergence between various departments to achieve the goals of conservation. Accordingly, a two-days online course on **‘Role of Judiciary in Forest and Wildlife’** for Judges and Magistrates of District & Subordinate Courts was held from 24th February to 25th February 2021. Keeping in view the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic situation, the course was conducted on an online mode using Microsoft Teams video conferencing application. A total number of 162 participants registered from 20 States for the training. However, 149 participants who had more than 80 percent attendance in the course were awarded Course Completion Certificates. The Course was designed keeping in view the professional interface between the Judiciary and Forest Department at various levels.

The training was inaugurated by Hon’ble Justice Swatanter Kumar, Former Judge, Supreme Court of India and Former Chairperson, National Green Tribunal as the Chief Guest. In the inaugural address, the Chief Guest spoke about the challenges in ensuring conservation of natural resources at length. He also referred to the principles of environmental jurisprudence while highlighting the proactive and creative role that judiciary plays in achieving the challenging task of conservation and environmental security in the country. The course included sessions handled by experienced resource persons on topics like legal issues in natural resource governance, insight into Indian Forest Act 1927, important judgments of Hon’ble Supreme Court and High Courts, Forest (Conservation) Act 1980, Biological Diversity Act 2002, insight into Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972, insight into wildlife related offence and Judicial activism in forestry and wildlife. Details of resource persons and schedule are enclosed as Appendices III and V in this report.

Valedictory session was presided over by Hon’ble Shri Saibal Dasgupta, IFS (Retd.) Expert Member, National Green Tribunal, South Zone Bench, Chennai as the Chief Guest. In his valedictory address, the Chief Guest flagged the importance of forest and wildlife conservation and discussed the need to address the various issues and challenges being faced by the sector. He also stressed the need for sensitivity towards ecological needs and unique features of legal cases pertaining to forests and wildlife. He appreciated the overall course design and overwhelming response by the participants. The Chief Guest also emphasized the need for more such trainings for better coordination in the field.

The soft copies of articles and write-ups related to the relevant topics covered during the course, apart from the copies of the presentations made by the experts and the recordings of each sessions were also provided to each participant as part of the training kit which was shared through Microsoft Share point and website.

Overall impact of the training was positive and the feedback and high rating from the participants corroborates the assessment of the organizers.

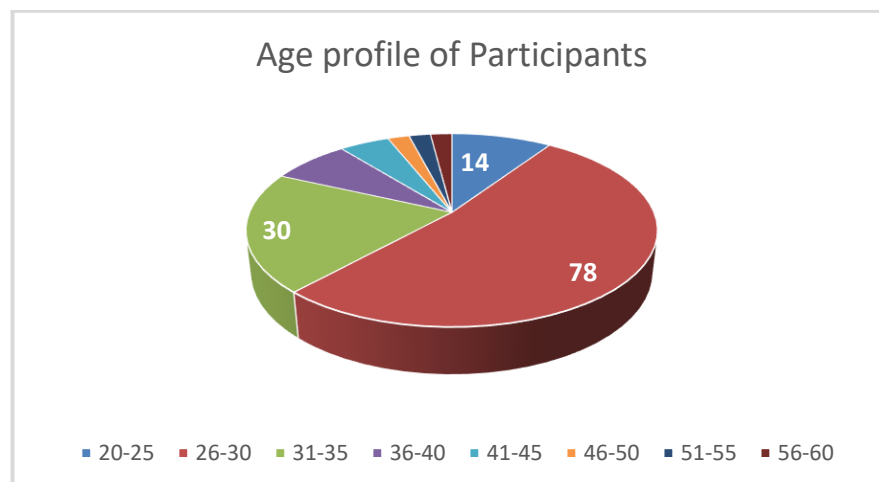

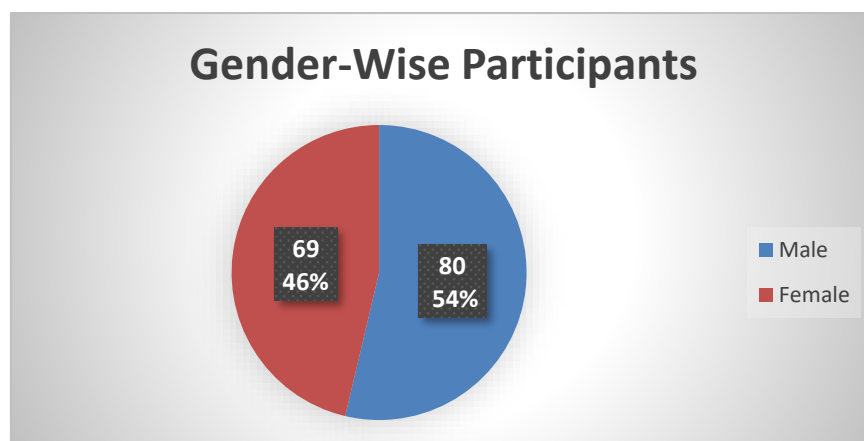
Overall Feedback of Resource Persons on all Parameters



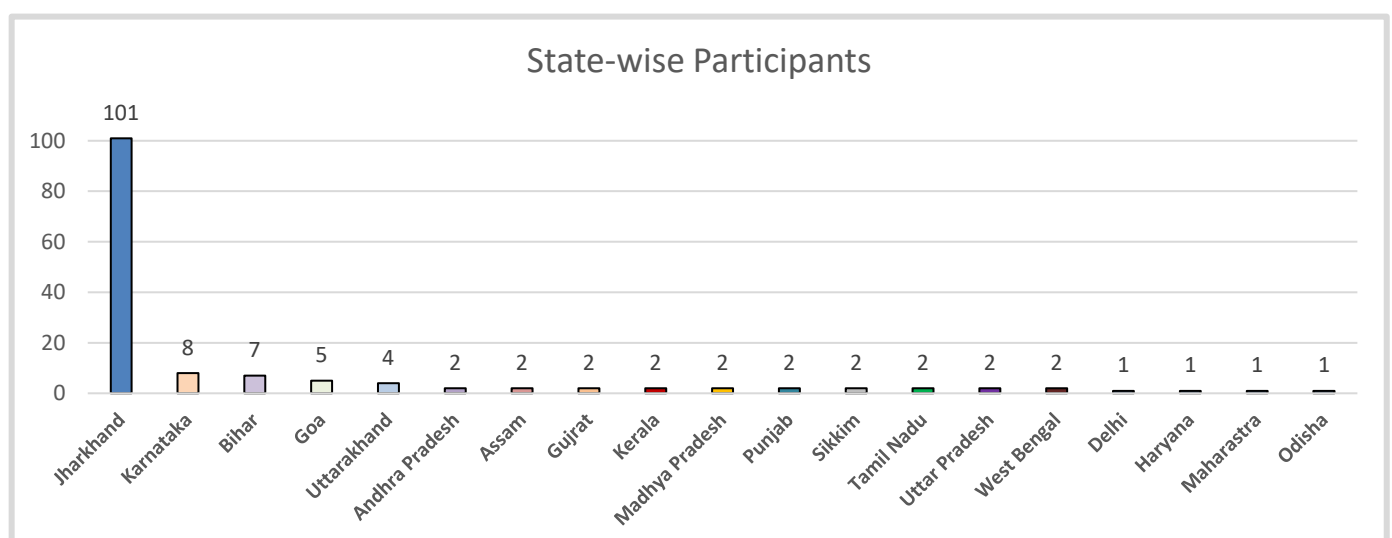
Parameter wise breakup of feedback of Resource Persons
