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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Burnihat under the aegis of Directorate of Forest Education (DFE) Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, took a step ahead of its mandate and conducted two days (14-07-2021 and 15-07-2021) training programme for Other Stakeholders such as Nature clubs/ Eco-clubs/ Educational Institutions on the theme "Conservation Education". The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India sponsored for the 'Training of other stakeholders' and 'Personnelof Other services' on topics/themes related to Forestry, Wildlife, Environment Management, Administration and related issues. In this backdrop, training of teachers' incharge of Eco-clubs on the theme of 'Conservation Education' was planned and organised. The training was conducted on virtual mode due to the current pandemic COVID-19 situation. 109 participants from 9 States across the country participated with overwhelming enthusiasm in this training programme.

The National Green Corps (NGC) popularly known as "a programme of Ecoclubs" is a nationwide initiative of the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change launched under the Environment Education Awareness and Training (EEAT). The scheme is being operated through Eco-clubs of 50-60 students having interest in environment related issues, formed in member schools. Eco clubs are supervised by a Teacher In-charge, who is selected from among the teachers of the member school.

The Course was inaugurated by the Chief Guest Dr. A. K. Johri IFS (Retd.), Former Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Assam. The Course Director of the training Shri C. A. Rahman IFS (Retd.), Contractual Associate Faculty, CASFoS welcomed the Chief Guest, Participants and gave a brief presentation about the Course. Dr. Beula Ezhil Mathi, Principal in-charge in her opening remarks emphasized the role of teachers in shaping the future of the country and expressed her belief that this training through sensitization of teachers in charge of Eco clubs would achieve the goal of nature conservationin Dr. A. K. Johri IFS (Retd.) in his inaugural address told that the school education system through Eco clubs gave space to the young minds to think and do out of the box beyond the curriculum and know about the importance of environment. He further emphasized Eco clubs not

only have impact on students but also on the parents and the neighbourhood. He asked to strengthen the existing linkage between the Forest department and Eco clubs to make the Environment Conservation efforts effective and efficient. And he also mentioned that assessment of Eco clubs is also needed and do play a role in mobilizing resources in Environment Conservation.

Guest Speakers/Resource persons like Dr. Pranav Trivedi, Conservationist, Navsari, Gujarat, Ms. Lima Rosalind, Director, Green Future Foundation, New Delhi, Dr. Narayan Sharma, Assistant Professor, Cotton University, Guwahati, Mr. S. Karthikeyan, Naturalist, Jungle Lodge Resorts, Karnataka, Mr. C. Srinivasan, Project Director, Indian Green Service, Vellore, Tamil Nadu, deliberated on various Environment Conservation related topic in this training programme. The topics covered in this training were Environmental Conservation issues in India; Back to Nature; Making Climate Change Education relevant; Citizen Science; Wildlife amidst humans; Domestic Solid and Liquid Resource management and Green Auditing of Schools. The detailed time table showing session-wise topics and Resource Persons is enclosed as *Annexure- 4*.

A total of 475 teachers/participants from 09 states across India registered for the training out of which 109 teachers/citizens from 09 states participated in the training programme. The training programme was very well appreciated by the participants who also requested for more of such training programmes regularly, for keeping up the momentum of environment conservation ideas. They also requested for State and district level trainings of teachers in charge of Eco clubs for maximum participation of Schools and Colleges. The Participants also urged for collaboration of Forest Department and Education Department in the States for effective implementation of Environment Conservation at the field level.

The copies of the presentations made by the experts in each session were provided in soft copy to each participant as part of the training kit through the Whatsapp group, email and Microsoft Team, from where they could also download the recordings of all the sessions.






