EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Central Academy for State Forest Service (CASFOS), Dehradun under the aegis of Directorate of Forest Education (DFE) Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, took a step ahead of its mandate and conducted two days (11.1.21 and 12.1.21) training programme for Lawyers and Defense counsels on the theme "Legal issues in Forest, Wildlife and Environment". The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Government of India sponsored for 'Training of other stakeholders' and 'Personnel of Other services' on topics/themes related to Forestry, Wildlife, Environment Mangement, Administration and related issues. In this backdrop, training of Lawyers and Defense counsels on the theme of 'Legal Issues in Forest, Wildlife and Environment' was planned and organised. The training was conducted on virtual mode due to the current pandemic COVID-19 situation.

The Course Director of the training, Dr T. Beula Ezhil mathi IFS, Lecturer, CASFOS gave a brief presentation about the course after which Mr Kunal Satyarthi IFS, Principal, CASFOS presented the opening remarks. In his opening remarks, he warmly welcomed the Chief guest Mr Bharat Jyoti IFS, Director, Indira Gandhi National Forest Academy, the guest of Honour Mr A.D.N Rao, Advocate, Hon. Supreme Court of India and all the participants of the training prgramme. He further stated the importance of collective stakeholder approach in environment conservation for which, this very step to conduct training for other stakeholders is taken up by the CASFOS. The Guest of Honour in his address sensitized the participants regarding the importance of protection of Environment. He further said that not only forest department but also the other stakeholders in the society has equally important role in natural resource and environment conservation. The guest of honour also highlighted and shared with examples, that judiciary has played proactive role in natural resource and environment conservation. The chief guest in his address has put forth various points to ponder upon on environment conservation and human development. He also said that there is a need to strike a balance between sustainable use of natural resources and humane attitude towards weaker sections for their development. He further emphasized that the participants - Lawyers /legal community has a good role in bringing up the same. Guest Speakers like Mr Uttam Kumar Sharma IFS, Mr.Ritwick Dutta, Supreme court Advocate, New Delhi, Mr.A.K Jha Retd IFS, Mr.T Rabi Kumar IFS, Mr S P Vashisht IFS and Mr Sanjay Upadhyay, Supreme court Advocate, New Delhi, along with in-house faculty Mr Kunal Satyarthi IFS deliberated on various topics related to Legal issues in Forest, Wildlife and Environment, in this training programme. The topics covered in this training were Legal issues in Natural Resource Governance-An overview, Insights of Indian forest Act 1927, Judicial Activism in Environmental sector, Forest Rights Act 2006 and Tribal livelihood, Biological Diversity Act 2002- implementation status, Insights of Wildlife Protection Act 1972, Important Supreme court and High court Judgements of Forests and wildlife The detailed time table showing session-wise topics and resource persons is enclosed as Annexure 5.

A total of 237 lawyers/defense counsels/law students from 25 States across India registered for the training out of which 88 lawyers/defense counsels/law students from 16 States successfully completed the training programme. The training programme was very well appreciated by the participants who also requested for more of such training programmes regularly, for keeping up the momentum of conservation of natural resources by effective legal backup. The reduction in the number of participants when compared to registered number was due to the court day for which the participants have suggested to conduct the training in the weekend.

A compendium of articles, presentations related to the relevant topics covered during the course, apart from the copies of the presentations made by the experts in each session were provided in soft copy to each trainee as part of the training kit through the Academy's website www.casfosddn.nic.in and also, through the SharePoint link provided to the participants, from where they could also download the recordings of all the sessions.
