The Assistant Conservator of Forests and newly promoted SFS Officers and Senior FROs who have put in a minimum of three years service and are below fifty six years of age are eligible for nomination for the above mentioned Training provided they have not undergone the same training earlier under the Directorate.

You are requested to nominate suitable Officers of your State for the Training at CASFoS, Dehradun as per the table given below. 
